



2023 Motorcycle Shows Info and Rules

Our ultimate goal is to get as much cool stuff into the shows as possible and allow everyone to display and/or compete. A variety of levels of customization are welcome.

- Classifications will be assigned by the Motorcycle show administrators, with the intent of comparing like-levels of customization within a class.
- Classifications are subject to change and are not guaranteed until all entries are in. Depending on the number of entries, we may break a classification down into sub classifications.
- If there is not a class open that has at least **three** entries and your bike cannot be combined with any other class, your entry fee may be refunded, and you will be permitted to keep the two free weekend passes. You are also welcome (and encouraged) to leave your bike on display for the weekend
- If at least **three** entries are not received in a particular class, show administrators reserve the right to combine dissimilar classes in the discretion of the Show judges.
- You are welcome to give input as to your bike's classification during registration and at move-in day. After that day, all classifications are final.
- In your presence at move-in day we will do our best to find the final resting position of your motorcycle/s. However, should it become necessary to move motorcycles for better accommodation, show administrators have (your expressed permission) to move your motorcycle/s to a different position.
- You must supply your own crowd barriers if barriers are desired.
- Turning on or starting your motorcycle to display the radio, motor, etc. is not permitted during show hours.
- Starting or removing your motorcycle is not permitted until after show closure.
- Photos of bikes may be used in future advertising by Motorcycle Expos.
- Bikes entered without good pictures may be rejected at move in.
- No stock bikes will be accepted, except for those in the Classic and Antique divisions.
- **Judges' decisions are final**

Judging note: Motorcycle Expos is promoting *custom* motorcycle shows, and the judging of show bikes is predicated on what modifications and alterations the judges can empirically qualify by looking at the bike on the floor. Unseen alterations to the motor and previous history at other bikes shows are not considered.
