MOVE IN HOURS:

FRIDAY JANUARY 30th, 2026: 8:00am until 7:00pm

NO VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE BUILDING ON SATURDAY

ALL BIKES MUST BE READY WITH AISLES CLEARED BY 9AM ON SATURDAY

ARRIVAL AT COMPLEX: Exit I-70 and go north on Brighton Blvd. Turn left into the complex when you arrive at Gate 7. Follow signs around to staging area, which will ultimately take you to the check-in site on North side of Expo Building. When approaching the check-in site, stay in the **LEFT LANE**. The right lane is for vendors and the left is for bike show/bike corral check-in.

DO NOT LEAVE YOUR VEHICLE AND WALK FORWARD AT ANY TIME YOU ARE IN LINE.

ONSITE CHECK IN: At the check-in shed you will be given a packet that contains all weekend passes and parking passes, if you have purchased any. You will also be directed on how and where to enter the building.

BALANCES OWED: If you still owe \$\$ for your bike registration, make sure to bring a credit card or cash to pay your balance.

LODGING: There are very limited spots for camping, so make other arrangements when possible. Contact for camping: 303-335-5134

SHOW HOURS:

SATURDAY JANUARY 31ST, 2026: 7:30am for You. 9:00am to 7:00pm for public.

SUNDAY FEBRUARY 1ST, 2026: 7:30am for You. 9:00am to 4:00pm for the public.

MOVE OUT HOURS/INFO:

Follow the same process as when you checked in. Go through gate 7 and get in the left lane. Bike show participants will be allowed to enter building 1st for bike loading. The doors for load out will open at approximately 4:10pm, after the crowd has exited the building. **NO BIKES CAN BE REMOVED BEFORE 4:00PM ON SUNDAY**

GENERAL INFO:

- **ANY VEHICLES LEFT INSIDE THE BUILDING DURING THE EVENT MUST BE PRE-APPROVED BY EXPO MANAGEMENT AND MUST HAVE LESS THAN ¼ TANK OF FUEL.**
- **NO ALCOHOL OR WEAPONS MAY BE BROUGHT INTO THE BUILDING.**
- **BY SUBMITTING YOUR ENTRY, YOU ACKNOWLEDGE YOU HAVE READ AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY [THE SWAP MEET VENDOR RULES AND REGULATIONS.](#)**

Absolutely NO Weapons Allowed on the Property

All Individuals Subject to Search

- Knives
- Guns
- Outside Alcohol
- Drugs (Of any kind)
- No smoking of any kind in the building (tobacco in designated outside smoking areas)
- No water bottles unless factory sealed or empty
- No Weapons - This includes brass knuckles, no large sticks and no spikes (walking canes are allowed)
- No Bags larger than: 10"x10"x3"
- No Coolers
- No backpacks
- Re-entry is Okay

Denver Fire Department Requirements for fueled vehicles indoors

- 1 - The maximum amount of fuel is a quarter of a tank not to exceed 5 gallons.
- 2 - The negative cable of the battery terminal shall be disconnected and taped.
- 3 - Move-in of vehicles shall be when the event is closed for business.
- 4 - ALL EXIT DOORS, CORRIDORS, and ALL EGRESS components shall REMAIN OPERATIONAL and UNOBSTRUCTED

Follow the red line back around to Gate 7 again, then back your trailer in diagonally as indicated by the green lines. Make sure to leave at least 6' between the back of your trailer and the railroad wall. This will make it easy to connect your trailer at move-out time and get right in line.
